and Unloading) Orders 198*

Notice is hereby given that the Cambridgeshire County Council propose to make Orders under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3), 32(1) to (4) and 35 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1986, and of all other enabling powers after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police, in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act, the effect of which will be to revoke a length of limited waiting at the northern end of Cromwell Place and to provide three parking places for Disabled Drivers only and to prohibit all loading and unloading at the north-west end of Cromwell Place.

Order 198*

Notice is hereby given that the Cambridgeshire County Council propose to make an Order under sections 45, 46, 49 and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1986 and of all other enabling powers after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police, in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act, the effect of which will be:

- (i) to remove the limited waiting in High Street, Huntingdon on the east side in the vicinity of the Surgery and No. 84 and on the west side in the vicinity of Nos. 60-68;
- (ii) to provide street parking places with charges in High Street where the limited waiting is to be removed (6 spaces on the east side and 9 spaces on the west side);
- (iii) to introduce a charge for parking in the existing parking places in Market Hill (17 spaces).

The charge referred to in (ii) and (iii) above will be 15p for a maximum stay of 1 hour with an excess charge of £10.

The parking places in High Street and Market Hill will operate between the hours of 7 a.m. and 6 p.m., Monday to Saturday (but not on market days in Market Hill).

The 5 parking places reserved for disabled persons vehicles in Market Hill will remain and will not be subject to any parking charge or time limit.

*The County of Cambridgeshire (Hartford Road, Huntingdon)
(Residents Parking Place) (Prohibition and Restriction of
Waiting) Orders 198*

Notice is hereby given that the Cambridgeshire County Council propose to make Orders under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3), 45, 46, 49 and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1986 and of all other enabling powers after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police, in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act, the effect of which will be:

- (i) to designate the side of road specified in the Schedule below as a parking place for residents of that length of Hartford Road, Huntingdon between High Street and Nursery Road, between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. Monday to Saturday;
- (ii) to restrict waiting to 1 hour in any 2 hours between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. Monday to Saturday, on part of the north-west side of that part of Hartford Road between High Street and Nursery Road;
- (iii) to prohibit waiting between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on any day on both sides of Hartford Road in the vicinity of the Fire Station.

The Parking Place Order will restrict the use of the parking place to residents' cars displaying a residents permit.

There will be a £15 annual administration charge for residents permits which will only be issued to residents of that part of Hartford Road referred to in paragraph (i) above.

The provisions of the Parking Place Order will not empower the Council to allocate parking places to individual residents. The granting of a permit will not guarantee that space will always be available in the parking place.
