Notice is hereby given that an application is being made to the Welsh Water Authority, Northern Division by Miss Kathleen Joan Smith of Felin Faesog, Tai'nlon, Clynnogfawr, Gwynedd LL54 5DD for a combined licence to obstruct or impede the flow of Afon Rhaedn (a tributary of Afon Desach) by means of A Weir at SH 442501, Parish of Clynnogfawr and to abstract 6,000 gallons of water per hour from the said inland water at or near that point.

The capacity of the reservoir at overflow level will be 80,000 gallons.
