- (c) Prohibit all vehicles from waiting at any time except taxis on South Street, on its western side, between points 2 metres and 17 metres north of the northern side of Trinity Street.

Exemptions will permit waiting for picking up or setting down passengers, loading or unloading goods, disabled persons' vehicles bearing the relevant orange badge, Post Office vehicles delivering and collecting mail, emergency service vehicles and where necessary, in connection with any building or demolition

operation, the maintenance of the road, the supply of gas, water or electricity and works to any telegraphic line.
