Vehicles will be allowed to wait for up to 30 minutes (no return within following 30 minutes) between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive in certain parts of Gateford Road at Worksop in the District of Bassetlaw:

Between its junctions with Sandy Lane Link Road and Overend Road.

The County of Hereford and Worcester (London Road, Marlborough Street and Foxwell Street, Worcester)
(Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1987

Notice is hereby given that Hereford and Worcester County Council propose to make an Order under section 1(1) and 2, 2(1) to 3 and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers the effect of which will be to prohibit waiting at any time on the sides of lengths of roads in the city of Worcester in the county of Hereford and Worcester specified in the Schedule to this Notice.

Exemptions in the Order will permit waiting for the purpose of:

- (a) picking up and setting down passengers;
- (b) loading and/or unloading goods;
- (c) delivering and collecting mail by Post Office vehicles;
- (d) delivering and collecting furniture and effects with police consent;
- (e) any building or demolition operation, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the roads and the supply of gas, electricity and water and maintenance of any telecommunications apparatus;
- (f) the fire brigade, ambulance or police services;
- (g) the pursuance of statutory powers or duties (if no other road can be conveniently used).

An exemption in the Order also permits the waiting by disabled persons' vehicles displaying a badge issued under the Local Authority's Orange Badge Scheme for a limited period of two hours, return prohibited within a further period of one hour.

Full details of these proposals are contained in the draft Order which together with a map showing the sides of lengths of roads affected and a Statement of the Council's Reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be examined from Monday to Friday during normal office hours at:

Notice is hereby given that on 19th November 1987 Hereford and Worcester County Council made an Order under section 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers the effect of which is to prohibit waiting at any time on the west side of A449 Worcester Road in the town of Malvern in the district of Malvern Hills in the county of Hereford and Worcester which extends for a distance of 10 metres (33 feet) north and south of its junction with Queen's Drive.
