(Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1987*

Notice is hereby given that the Borough Council of Pendle pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972, with Lancashire County Council in exercise of the powers of the said County Council proposes to make the above-mentioned Order under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order will be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles at any time of the lengths of road specified on the Schedule to this Notice.

The Order will contain exemptions for the picking-up and setting down of passengers, emergency vehicles, vehicles being used for the delivery and collection of postal packets as defined in section 87 of the Post Office Act 1953, vehicles used in connection with the construction and demolition works, the maintenance of roads, the supply of gas, electricity or water or of any telegraphic lines as defined in the Telegraph Act 1878, loading and unloading of goods, local authority vehicles being used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties and the parking in invalid carriages and other vehicles used by disabled persons.

A disabled person's vehicle in which is displayed a disabled person's badge and parking disc will be permitted to wait for a period not exceeding 2 hours.

A copy of the Order and of the relevant map be inspected at the Town Hall, Market Street, Nelson, between the hours of 9 a.m. and 5.30 p.m. on Monday to Thursday, and 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. on Friday.

(Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1987*

Notice is hereby given that the Borough Council of Pendle pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972, with Lancashire County Council in exercise of the powers of the said County Council has made an Order under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The Order which will come into force on 1st December 1987, will prohibit the waiting of vehicles between the hours of 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays on both both sides of Hallam Road, Nelson, from a point 55 metres to the west of the junction of Hallam Crescent with Hallam Road which is adjacent to No. 3 Hallam Crescent for a distance of 65 metres in a westerly direction.

The Order will contain exemptions for the picking-up and setting down of passengers, emergency vehicles, vehicles being used for the delivery and collection of postal packets as defined in section 87 of the Post Office Act 1953, vehicles used in connection with the construction and demolition works, the maintenance of roads, the supply of gas, electricity or water or of any telegraphic lines as defined in the Telegraph Act 1878, loading and unloading of goods, local authority vehicles being used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties and the parking in invalid carriages and other vehicles used by disabled persons.

A disabled person's vehicle in which is displayed a disabled person's badge and parking disc will be permitted to wait for a period not exceeding 2 hours.

Any persons wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any provisions contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or of any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within 6 weeks from 27th November 1987, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
