TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

Stopping up of a Part Width of Middleton Road, Chadderton

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that on the application of Oldham Metropolitan Borough Council he has made an Order under section 209 of the above Act entitled "The Stopping up of Highways (Metropolitan Borough of Oldham) (No. 4) Order 1987" authorising the stopping up of a part width of the northerly footway of Middleton Road, Chadderton to enable development to be carried out in accordance with planning permission.

Proposed Pedestrianisation of a Length of Elm Road, Seaforth, Liverpool

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that on the application of the Sefton Metropolitan Borough Council he proposes to make an Order under section 212 of the above Act to provide for the extinguishment of any right which persons may have to use vehicles on a length of Elm Road, Seaforth, Liverpool.

The proposed Order will contain provisions for permitting the use of that highway by vehicles being used:

- (a) for police, ambulance or fire brigade purposes;
- (b) in connection with the laying, erection, inspection, maintenance, alteration, repair, renewal or removal in or near the said length of highway of any sewer, main pipe, conduit, wire, cable or other apparatus for the supply of gas, water, electricity or of any telecommunication apparatus as defined in Schedule 2 to the Telecommunications Act 1984.

and where the vehicle is:

- (i) a vehicle being used by the local authority in pursuance of their statutory powers and duties.
- (ii) a pedal cycle.

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 6)

The A205 Trunk Road (Catford Hill, Lewisham) (Prescribed Routes) Order 198

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he intends to make the above-named Order the effect of which would be:

- (a) to require any vehicle proceeding in the Wickes site access road on reaching its junction with the south-west bound carriageway of Catford Hill to turn left;
- (b) to require any vehicle proceeding in the Wickes site access road, when entering Catford Hill, to pass to the left of the island site at the junction;
- (c) to require any vehicle proceeding in the south-west bound carriageway of Catford Hill, when entering the Wickes site access road, to pass to the left of the island site at the junction; and
- (d) to prohibit any vehicle proceeding in the north-east bound carriageway of Catford Hill from making a right turn into the Wickes site access road.
