NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR LICENCE TO, ABSTRACT WATER

Notice is hereby given that an application is being made to the Welsh Water Authority (Northern Division), Penrhosgarnedd, Bangor, Gwynedd, by Andrew William Batty, 7 Mill Terrace, Afonwen, Near Mold, Clwyd, CH7 5UF, for a licence to abstract the following quantities of water from Ffynnon, Asaph Stream, at the following point of abstraction: 201.3 million gallons per annum at SJ07467903; 800,000 gallons per day; 33,333 gallons per hour, in the Civil Parish of Trelawnyd, in the District of Delyn.

Further details of the application are: The abstraction is for the purpose of a fish hatchery at Ffynnon, Asaph, Dyserth.
