The Trunk Road (A494) (Aston Hill, Clwyd) (Closure of Central Reserve Crossing) Order 1988

Notice is hereby given that on 5th February 1988, the Secretary of State made the above Orderwhich will come into force on 7th March 1988.

The effect of the Order is as stated in Notice 2SI in the *London Gazette* No. 51048 dated 1st September 1987.

If any person desires to question the validity of the Order, or of any provision contained therein, on the grounds:—

(a) that it is not within the powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984,

or (b) that his interests have been substantially prejudiced by a failure to comply with any of the requirements of that Act,

he may within 6 weeks of the 5th February 1988, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any

provision contained therein.
