(Featherstall Road/Whitelees Road, Littleborough) (Prohibition of Waiting and Restriction of Loading/Unloading) (Borough) Order 1988

(Ann Street, Rochdale) (One Way Working) (Borough) Order 1988

Notice is hereby given that the Rochdale Borough Council, in exercise of its powers under Section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to introduce:—

1. *No Waiting at Any Time and No Loading/Unloading, Monday-Saturday, 8 a.m.-9.30 a.m. and Monday-Friday, 4 p.m.-6 p.m. on:*
 - (a) *Smith Bridge Road* northerly side from its junction with Henry Street to a point 15 metres east of its junction with Brown Lodge Street;
 - (b) *Henry Street* both sides from its junction with Smithy Bridge Road for 15 metres in a north-easterly direction;
 - (c) *Brown Lodge Street* both sides from its junction with Smithy Bridge Road for 15 metres in a northerly direction.
2. *No Waiting at Any Time and No Loading/Unloading, Monday-Saturday, 7.30 a.m.-9.30 a.m., 4 p.m.-6.30 p.m. on:*
 - (a) *Featherstall Road* northerly side from the easterly side of Foxcroft Street to a point approximately 12 metres east of its junction with Whitelees Road;
 - (b) *Whitelees Road*
 - (i) north-westerly side from its junction with Featherstall Road to a point approximately 35 metres north-east of this junction;
 - (ii) south-easterly side from its junction with Featherstall Road to a point approximately 30 metres north-east of this junction.
3. *One Way Working on: Anne Street* — from Drake Street to Great George Street in that direction.

The proposed Orders would contain certain exemptions relating to emergency vehicles and statutory undertakers, disabled persons, persons boarding and alighting from vehicles.

Copies of the Order and maps showing the lengths of road concerned may be inspected at the Information Office, Municipal Offices, Smith Street, Rochdale between the hours of 9.30 a.m.-12.30 p.m. and 2 p.m.-4.45 p.m. Mondays to Fridays inclusive.

Objections to the proposed Order stating the grounds on which they are made must be sent in writing to the undersigned by 31st March 1988.
