ACQUISITION OF LAND ACT 1981

The A406 London North Circular Trunk Road (Hanger Lane to Harrow Road Improvement) Compulsory Purchase Order (No.) 198

Tokyngton Recreation Ground

The Secretary of State for Transport has prepared this draft compulsory Order which he proposes to make. If made it will authorise the purchase of land which forms part of an open space as defined in the Acquisition of Land Act 1981, that is, land laid out as a public garden or used for the purposes of public recreation or a disused burial ground. This land is described in the First Schedule to this notice and is shown coloured pink on the map referred to in paragraph 4 below.

The Order will be subject to special parliamentary procedure unless the Secretary of State for the Environment gives a certificate under section 19(1) of the Act. He has been asked by the Secretary of State for Transport to certify under section 19(1)(a) that he is satisfied that other land has been or will be given in exchange for the open space, which is not less in area and is equally advantageous to any persons entitled to rights of common or other rights and to the public, and that the land given in exchange has been or will be vested in the persons in whom the open space was vested, subject to the like rights, trusts and incidents as attach to the open space. The land proposed to be given in exchange is described in the Second Schedule hereto and is shown coloured green on the maps referred to in paragraph 4 below.

The Secretary of State is required to give formal notice of his intention to issue a certificate before he reaches a decision, to give an opportunity for objections to be made. He hereby gives such notice. Any representations or objections in relation to this proposal should be made in writing and addressed to the Department of the Environment, Room 2543, Millbank Tower, 21-24 Millbank, London SW1P 4QU before 24th March 1988, quoting GLP 5006/10/1.

Maps showing the open space proposed to be purchased and the land proposed to be given in exchange may be seen, without payment, at the offices of the Department of Transport, Room C7/06, 2 Marsham Street, London SW1P 3EB and at the offices of the London Borough of Brent, Brent House, 349 High Road, Wembley, Middlesex; at the offices of the London Borough of Ealing, Technical Services' Department, 24 Uxbridge Road,

London W.5; at the Tokyngton Public Library, Monks Park, Wembley, Middlesex; and at Ealing Central Library, 103 Ealing Broadway Centre, London W.5, at all reasonable hours.

The Secretary of State for the Environment may, if he considers it expedient, hold a public local inquiry into the matter.

The A406 London North Circular Trunk Road (Hanger Lane to Harrow Road Improvement, Trunk Road and Slip Roads) Order 1988

The A406 London North Circular Trunk Road (Hanger Lane to Harrow Road Improvement, Side Roads) Order 1988

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he has made the following Orders:

1. an Order under sections 10 and 41 of the Highways Act 1980, the effect of which is to provide that roads which he proposes to construct along the following routes shall become trunk roads as from the date when the Order comes into force:
 - (i) a route (the main route) at Stonebridge and Tokyngton in the London Borough of Brent, about 1,250 metres in length starting at a point on the A406 London North Circular Trunk Road at the east side of the Grand Union Canal (Paddington Branch) then going in a generally north-eastwards direction ending at a point on the Trunk Road about 280 metres north-east of its junction with the A404 Harrow Road;
 - (ii) four routes for slip roads to connect the north-east bound and south-west bound carriageways of the main route with a proposed new unclassified road to link the main new trunk road with Twyford Abbey Road at Stonebridge; and
 - (iii) four routes for slip roads to connect the north-east and south-west bound carriageways of the main route with the A404 road at Stonebridge and Tokyngton.
2. an Order under sections 12, 14 and 125 of the Highways Act 1980 authorising him:
 - (a) to improve, raise, lower or otherwise alter highways;
 - (b) to stop up highways;
 - (c) to construct new highways;
 - (d) to stop up private means of access to premises; and
 - (e) to provide new means of access to premises,

all at West Twyford in the London Borough of Ealing and at Stonebridge and Tokyngton aforesaid and providing for the transfer of each of the said new highways to the highway authority specified therefor in the Order as from the date on which he notifies that authority that the new highways have been completed and are open for through traffic, except for the footpaths and cycle tracks crossing over or under the Trunk Road which will remain the responsibility of the Secretary of State.
