#### CLEAN AIR ACT 1956

#### LOCAL GOVERNMENT PLANNING AND LAND ACT 1980

#### *The City of Peterborough Smoke Control (No. 17) Order 1988*

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the City of Peterborough of the Town hall, Peterborough, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act 1956 (as amended), has made an Order entitled "The City of Peterborough Smoke Control (No. 17) Order 1988" declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a smoke control area.

The Order will come into force on 1st September 1988 and subject to any exemptions and limitations for the time being in force under section 11 of the Act, if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from the Chimney of any building within the smoke control area, the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence, and liable to a fine not exceeding one hundred pounds (£100) unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

A copy of the Order and map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the Town Hall, Peterborough during normal office hours.

All that part of the City of Peterborough (shown coloured green on the map referred to in the draft Order) bounded on the north by the centre line of Mountsteven Avenue from Lincoln Road to the point adjacent to the rear of 116 Churchfield Road, then following the boundary of Mountsteven Recreation ground to the passageway between Nos. 47 and 49 Croyland Road, across on the centre line of Holland Avenue extending on to Fulbridge Road to the junction with Fane Road. *On the East* by the centre line of Fane Road to the junction with Willesden Avenue. *On the South* by the centre line of Willesden Avenue to rear of properties on east side of Lincoln Road. *On the West* by a line running along rear of properties on the east side of Lincoln Road from Willesden Avenue to Mountsteven Avenue.
