LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The Lancashire County Council (Parr Lane, Eccleston, Chorley Borough) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1988

Notice is hereby given that the Lancashire County Council have made an Order under section 1, 2 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles, at any time on any day in either of the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Notice.
