*The County of Dyfed (Water Street, Carmarthen)
(Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1988*

Notice is hereby given that the Dyfed County Council propose to make an Order under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of this Order will be:

- (1) To prohibit waiting at any time on the side of road specified in the Schedule to this Notice.
- (2) To revoke the County of Carmarthenshire (Various Streets, Carmarthen) (One-Way Traffic and Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1969 insofar as it relates to the side of road specified in the Schedule to this Notice.

The Order will contain the usual exemptions including the right for passengers to board or alight from a vehicle, for the loading and unloading of goods, for the carrying out of building operations and other works, for the performance of statutory powers or duties, and to enable a vehicle to take in petrol, oil, water or air from any garage situated adjacent to the side of road affected by the proposed restriction.

In addition, the Order will contain the usual parking concessions for disabled persons in accordance with the Orange Badge Scheme.

Full details of these proposals are contained in the draft Order which, together with a map showing the side of road affected and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be examined at the offices of the Dyfed County Council at County Hall, Carmarthen, during normal office hours.

If you wish to object to the proposed Order you should send the grounds for your objection in writing to the undersigned by 28th March 1988.

(Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1988*

Notice is hereby given that the Dyfed County Council propose to make an Order under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of this Order will be to prohibit waiting between the hours of 9 a.m. and 6 p.m. on any day except Sunday in the lengths of road and side of road specified in the Schedule to this Notice.

The Order will contain the usual exemptions including the right for passengers to board or alight from a vehicle, for the loading and unloading of goods, for the carrying out of building operations and other works, for the performance of statutory powers or duties, and to enable a vehicle to take in petrol, oil, water or air from any garage situated adjacent to the lengths of road and side of road affected by the proposed restriction.

In addition, the Order will contain the usual parking concessions for disabled persons in accordance with the Orange Badge Scheme.

GREAT GRIMSBY BOROUGH COUNCIL

*The Borough of Great Grimsby (Freeman Street)
(Prohibition of Traffic (No. 31) Order 1988*

Notice is hereby given that the Great Grimsby Borough Council, acting as agent for the Highway Authority, the County Council of Humberside, propose to make a Road Traffic Regulation Order, under powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which is as follows:

1. To prohibit driving in Freeman Street in that part from the northern kerb-line of Garibaldi Street to the southern kerb-line of Nelson Street.
2. To revoke existing restrictions for no waiting 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday to Saturday in Freeman Street in that part from the southern kerb-line of Garibaldi Street to the northern kerb-line of Nelson Street.
3. To revoke existing restrictions for a one-way street in Thesiger Street, in the direction from north to south, in that part between Nelson Street and Garibaldi Street.

SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL

The County Council of Surrey (Various Roads in Albury, Christmaspie and Wanborough, Compton, Ripley, Send, Shalford, Shere, West Clandon, West Horsley, Wood Street Village and Worplesdon) (Restricted Roads) Order 1987

Notice is hereby given that Surrey County Council have made the above-mentioned Order under sections 82 and 83 of and Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order is to impose restricted road status (30 m.p.h. speed limit) on the roads and lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice.
