The Wandsworth (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (No. 1) Experimental Traffic Order 1988

Notice is hereby given that the Wandsworth Borough Council on 26th February 1988 made the above-mentioned Order under section 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Local Government Act 1985.

The general effect of the Order will be to apply in modified form the provisions of the Wandsworth (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1976 so that:

- in the lengths of Replingham Road specified in Schedule 1 to this Notice waiting by vehicles (otherwise than for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) will be prohibited between 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive;
- in the lengths of Replingham Road specified in Schedule 2 to this Notice waiting by vehicles (otherwise than for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) will be prohibited between 7 a.m. and 7.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive;
- the sale or offer for sale of goods from a vehicle will be prohibited, except on a Sunday, unless there is in force a valid licence issued by the Wandsworth Borough Council or the goods are immediately taken into or delivered at premises adjacent to the vehicle from which the sale is effected;
- the use of any vehicle or of any animal or the wearing of fancy dress or other costume, wholly or mainly for the purpose of advertising, will be prohibited.

The prohibitions referred to in paragraph 2(a) and (b) above will not apply in respect of anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or in certain circumstances, e.g. the picking up or setting down of passengers; the carrying out of statutory powers or duties; the taking in of petrol, etc., from roadside petrol stations; to licensed street traders, etc. The usual exemption relating to vehicles displaying a disabled person's "Orange Badge" will apply.

The Order provides that in pursuance of section 10(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Borough Engineer or some person authorised in that behalf by him, may, if it appears to him or that person essential in the interests of the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of traffic or for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which any road affected by the Order runs, modify or suspend the Order or any provision thereof.

A copy of the Order, which will come into operation on 14th March 1988, of the Wandsworth (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1976 (and of the Orders which have amended that Order) and of the Council's statement of reasons for making the Order can be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive, until the expiration of a period of 6 months from that date, in The Concourse, The Town Hall, Wandsworth High Street, London SW18 2PU.

Copies of the Order may be obtained from the Administration Department, Room 153, The Town Hall, Wandsworth High Street, London SW18 2PU.

Any person desiring to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within 6 weeks of the date on which the Order was made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.

If the provisions of the Order continue in operation for a period of not less than 6 months, the Council will consider in due course whether the provisions of the Order should be reproduced and continued in force indefinitely by means of an Order under section 6 of the said Act of 1984. Persons desiring to object to the making of the Order under section 6 of the said Act of 1984 for the purpose of such reproduction and continuation in force may, within the afore-mentioned period of 6 months, send a statement in writing of their objection and the grounds thereof to the Department of Administration, The Town Hall, Wandsworth High Street, London SW18 2PU, quoting the reference DA/AR/ORD.

The Wandsworth (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Amendment No. 37) Order 1988

Notice is hereby given that Wandsworth Borough Council on 26th February 1988, made the above-mentioned Order under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by section 8 of and Part I of Schedule 5 to the Local Government Act 1985.

The general effect of the Order will be further to amend the Wandsworth (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1976, so that:

- waiting by vehicles (other than for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) will be prohibited between 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive in the length of Chestnut Grove specified in the Schedule to this Notice;
- the sale or offer for sale of goods from a vehicle will be prohibited, except on a Sunday, unless there is in force a valid licence issued by the Wandsworth Borough Council or the goods are immediately taken into or delivered at premises adjacent to the vehicle from which the sale is effected;
