ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

The County of Hereford and Worcester (UC21446 Library Way, Rubery) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1988

Notice is hereby given that on 3rd March 1988, Hereford and Worcester County Council made an Order under section 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers the effect of which is:

- (a) to prohibit waiting at any time on that length of UC21446 Library Way in Rubery in the district of Bromsgrove in the county of Hereford and Worcester from a point on the north-east side which is 34 metres (112 feet) from its junction with New Road, extending to a point 46 metres (151 feet) from New Road on the south-west side, a total distance of 34 metres (112 feet), constituting the whole of the turning head;
- (b) to prohibit waiting between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Monday to Saturday on that length of the south-west side of the UC21446 Library Way in Rubery in the district of Bromsgrove in the county of Hereford and Worcester which extends from a point 34 metres (112 feet) north-west of its junction with New Road, for a distance of 12 metres (39 feet) in a north-westerly direction, for a period exceeding 1 hour (return prohibited within 2 hours).

The Order will come operation on 15th March 1988.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in the Order on the ground that it is not within the powers of the relevant section of the Act or on the ground that any requirement of that section or of Parts I, II or III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, or of any regulations made under the said Part III of Schedule 9 has been complied with in relation to the Order, may within 6 weeks of the date on which the Order was made (such date stated in this Notice) make application for the purpose to the High Court.

The County of Hereford and Worcester (C2180 Alcester Road, Wythall) (Restriction of Waiting) Order 1988

Notice is hereby given that on 3rd March 1988, Hereford and Worcester County Council made an Order under section 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3), 4(2) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers the effect of which is to prohibit waiting between the hours of 8.15 a.m. to 9.15 a.m. and 3 p.m. to 4 p.m. on Monday to Friday, inclusive on that length of the east side of C2180 Alcester Road in the parish of Wythall in the district of Bromsgrove in the county of Hereford and Worcester which extends from a point 15 metres north of its junction with Houndsfield Lane for a distance of 28 metres in a northerly direction.
