

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

The Stopping Up of Highways (County of Essex) (No. 2) Order 1988

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that, on the application of Mr T. J. Faulkner, he has made an Order under section 209 of the above Act entitled "The Stopping up of Highways (County of Essex) (No. 2) Order 1988" authorising the stopping up of highway land at Kingley Drive, Wickford adjacent to No. 18 Castledon Road, Wickford to enable development consisting of a change of use to garden land and the erection of a boundary wall to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted to Mr Faulkner by Basildon District Council.

Copies of the Order may be obtained, free of charge, on application to the Eastern Regional Office (Transport), Departments of the Environment and Transport, Heron House, 49-51 Goldington Road, Bedford MK40 3LL (quoting 520935/1/15) and may be inspected at all reasonable hours at the offices of the Basildon District Council, The Rylands, London Road, Wickford.

Any person aggrieved by the Order and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the above Act or that any requirement of that Act or of any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within 6 weeks of 11th March 1988, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that on the application of the North Yorkshire County Council, he proposes to make an Order under section 212 of the above Act to provide for the extinguishment of any right which persons may have to use vehicles on a length of Kex Gill Moor Road, west of Blubberhouses, near Otley.

The proposed Order will contain provisions for permitting the use of that highway where the vehicle is using the highway in accordance with a special authorisation in writing for that use given by or on behalf of the North Yorkshire County Council.

During 28 days from 11th March 1988, copies of the draft Order and relevant plan may be inspected at the Harrogate Borough Council Offices, Knapping Mount, West Grove Road, Harrogate and at No. 3 Area Office, 3 Croft House, Carleton Road, Skipton and may be obtained free of charge from the Department of Transport (quoting YHRT5069/41/17/1) at the address stated below.

Within the above-mentioned period of 28 days, any person may by notice to the Secretary of State (ref: YHRT5069/41/17/1), at his address at the office of the Director (Transport), Yorkshire and Humberside Region, City House, Leeds LS1 4JD, object to the making of the Order.
