

Exemptions

- (a) to enable persons to board or alight, from a vehicle;
- (b) to enable goods to be loaded onto or unloaded from a vehicle;
- (c) vehicles used for building or demolition operations' funerals, weddings, roadworks, works on sewers or statutory undertakers' equipment;
- (d) vehicles used in pursuance of statutory powers and duties;
- (e) disabled persons' vehicles for up to 2 hours, return prohibited within one hour.

Full details of the proposals are in the draft Orders which, together with maps showing the lengths of roads referred to and statements of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Orders, may be examined at my office between the hours of 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays. (Room 447, telephone 061 678 4711).

KIRKLEES METROPOLITAN COUNCIL

(Traffic Regulation) (No. 16) Order 1987

Bridge Street, Ravensthorpe

Notice is hereby given that the Kirklees Metropolitan Council made the above-named Order on 8th March 1988 under their powers in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which is that no person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in the length of Bridge Street at Ravensthorpe which extends from its junction with the north-western kerb-line of Huddersfield Road for a distance of 5 metres in a north-westerly direction.

The Order comes into operation on Monday, 14th March 1988. A copy of the Order, together with a map showing the affected road, may be examined during normal office hours at:

- (2) At Reception, Traffic Group, 1st Floor, Oldgate House, Oldgate, Huddersfield; and

If you wish to question the validity of the Order, or of any provisions contained therein, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may within 6 weeks from the date on which the Order was made (i.e. by 19th April 1988) apply to the High Court for this purpose.

CLWYD COUNTY COUNCIL

The County Council of Clwyd (Unnamed Lane adjacent to Ysgol Penrhyn Junior School, New Broughton) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 1988

Notice is hereby that on 8th March 1988, the Clwyd County Council made the above-named Order under sections 1(1) and (2) and 2(1) to (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which is to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding in that length of the unnamed lane situated adjacent to Ysgol Penrhyn Junior School, New Broughton in the borough of Wrexham Maelor in the county of Clwyd (linking Rhosrhedyn Lane and Wrexham Road) which extends from its junction with Rhosrhedyn Lane for a distance of 83 metres in an easterly direction, except vehicles requiring access to property or apparatus situated on or adjacent to that length of road.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within 6 weeks from 8th March 1988 apply to the High Court for this purpose.
