

- (b) provide that the parking place would operate between 8.30 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive except for Christmas Day, Good Friday and Bank Holidays;
- (c) specify, that disabled persons' vehicles displaying in the relevant position a disabled person's badge ("orange badge") issued by any local authority under the provisions of the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 1975 or 1982 may be left in the parking place; and
- (d) provide that certain vehicles may wait in the parking place in certain circumstances, e.g., to allow persons to board or alight (maximum 20 minutes), etc.
