**The Classes of Vehicles for which the Parking Places are available are as follows:**

Motor vehicles constructed or adapted solely to carry not more than 12 passengers (exclusive of the driver) and their effects, and dual purpose and private and light goods vehicles of an unladen weight not exceeding 1525Kgs.

- (i)-(iii) and (a)-(x) inclusive: all classes not to exceed 6ft 6ins in height and/or 18ft in length.
- (iv) All classes not to exceed 6ft in height inclusive of any goods attached to the roof and/or 18ft in length.

**The Days of Operation of the Car Parks are as follows:**

- (i)-(iii) and (a)-(x) all days.
- (iii)-(iv)-Monday to Saturday.

**The House of Operation of the Car Parks are as follows:**

- (i)-(ii) and (a)-(x)-all hours.
- (iii)-7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Monday to Saturday (car parks closed and locked at all other times including Sundays and public holidays unless alternative hours are approved to meet a specific demand).
- (iv)-Monday, Tuesday and Saturday 8 a.m. to 6.30 p.m. Wednesday, Thursday and Friday 8 a.m. to 8.30 p.m. (Friday late night 8 a.m. to 9.30 p.m.) (Free parking after 6.30 p.m.) (car park closed and locked at all other times including Sundays, public holidays unless alternative hours are approved to meet a specific demand).

**The Maximum Period for which Vehicles may wait is as follows:**

- (i)-(ii) and (a)-(x)-28 days.
- (iii)-12 hours.
- (iv)-Monday, Tuesday and Saturday 10½ hours. Wednesday, Thursday and Friday 12½ hours. Friday (late night) 13½ hours.

**The Charging Period is as follows:**

- (i) 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. Monday-Saturday.
- (ii) All hours Monday-Saturday.
- (iii) 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Monday-Saturday.

**The Scale of Charges is as follows:**

- (ii) 7.30 a.m. to 6.30 p.m. Up to 1 hour: 25p. 1 to 2 hours: 30p. 2 to 4 hours: 40p. Over 4 hours: 50p. 6.30 p.m. to 7.30 a.m. Any period 30p.
- (iii) 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Each period up to 12 hours: 15p. Free period during the 2 week prior to Christmas Day each year.
- (iv) 8 a.m. to 6.30 p.m. Up to 2 hours: 35p. 2 to 4 hours: 50p. 4 to 6 hours: 70p. Over 6 hours: £1.10. Wednesday and Thursday 6.30 a.m. to 8.30 p.m., 9.30 p.m. Friday late night free Parking.

**Motor Cycles**

**The Enfield (Off Street Lorry Parking Places) Order 1988**

Notice is hereby given that the Enfield London Borough Council proposes to make an Order under sections 35(1), (3) and (6) and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which is to:

- (a) revoke the Enfield (Off Street Lorry Parking Places) Order 1987; and
- (b) revise the lorry parking charges with effect from 11th April 1988.

The park affected by the Order is the Willoughby Lane Lorry Park, Leaside Road, Edmonton, N18. The classes of vehicles for which the parking places are available are goods vehicles in excess of 5 tonnes and gvw public service vehicles. The park operates all hours during all days of the week. The maximum continuous period for which vehicles may wait is 31 days. The charging period is 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. The scale of charges (inclusive of VAT at 15%) is as follows.
