WOKING BOROUGH COUNCIL

Woking Borough Council (Various Roads) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Amendment Order No. 24 1988

Notice is hereby given that the Woking Borough Council on behalf of the County Council of Surrey, pursuant to arrangements entered into under section 101(1)(b) of the Local Government Act 1972 and in exercise of the powers contained in sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) and part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, propose to make an Order amending the Woking Borough Council (Various Streets) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Consolidation Order 1974 the effect of which will be:

- (i) to prohibit waiting at any time in the lengths of road specified in Schedule A;
- (ii) to restrict waiting between the hours of 8.30 a.m. and 6 p.m. in the lengths of road specified in Schedule B;
- (iii) to restrict waiting between the hours of 8.30 a.m. and 6 p.m. (Monday to Friday) in the lengths of road specified in Schedule D;

Exemptions are provided in the Order to permit vehicles to wait in order to pick up and put down passengers, to load and unload goods (unless specifically prohibited), to carry out essential services or when used by local authorities in pursuance of statutory powers or duties, for a disabled persons vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled persons badge and parking disc, and for furniture removals.

A copy of the Order and relevant maps, together with the statement of reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be examined at the Civic Offices, Gloucester Square, Woking, on weekdays during normal office hours.

No waiting at any time

1. Link Road between The Grove and Ferndale Road, Horsell, both sides.
2. St Michael's Road, Sheerwater, the south-east side, from a point opposite the western boundary of No. 144 St Michael's Road for a distance of 15 metres in a north-easterly direction.

SCHEDULE B

No waiting between 8.30 a.m. and 6 p.m.

Hill View Road, the northside:

- (i) from a point parallel with the western flank wall of Nos. 1-14 Hill View Court for a distance of 16 metres in an easterly direction; and
- (ii) from a point 13 metres west of the eastern boundary of Ravenswood Court for a distance of 40 metres in a westerly direction.

- Kingfield Road, Kingfield (A247) (west and south-west sides), 8.30 a.m. to 6 p.m.
- Mount Hermon Road (north side), 24 hours.
- Oyster Lane, Byfleet (east side), 24 hours.
- St. Michael's Road, Sheerwater (south-west, north-east and south-east sides), 24 hours.
- White Rose Lane (east side), 8.30 a.m. to 6 p.m.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order, or of any provision contained in the Order, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the relevant section of the Act or on the ground that any requirement of that section or of Part I, Part II or Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act or any regulations made under the said Part III has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within 6 weeks of 16th March 1988, the date of making the Order, make application for this purpose to the High Court.
