

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 209 of the above Act to authorise the stopping-up of a length of Back Carlton Road, South Elmsall to enable development consisting of an Access Road from Carlton Road to the proposed Enterprise Centre to be carried out by the City of Wakefield Metropolitan District Council under part III of the said Act.

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

SECTION 6

The A13 Trunk Road (East India Dock Road, Tower Hamlets) (Prescribed Routes) Order 1988

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he has made the above-named Order the effect of which is to make permanent the provisions of the existing experimental Order which prohibits any vehicle:

- (a) proceeding eastwards or westwards in East India Dock Road (A13) from entering or passing through the gap in the central reservation of that road which lies opposite Brunswick Road; and
- (b) proceeding eastwards in that length of East India Dock Road between the eastern extremity of the said central reservation and Abbott Road, from making a 'U' turn.

A17 Trunk Road (East Bank, Sutton Bridge) (Traffic Regulation) Order 198
