The Islington (Parking Places) (Diplomatic Missions) (No. 1) Order 1988

The Islington (Parking Places) (Amendment No. 7) Order 1988 Relating to Worship Street, London E.C.2

Notice is hereby given that the London Borough of Islington did on 15th March 1988 make the above-mentioned Orders under sections 6 and 45 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Local Government Act 1985.

waiting by vehicles (otherwise than for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) would be prohibited between the hours of 8 a.m. to 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive in the length of streets specified in the Schedule to this Notice.

LEWISHAM LONDON BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Lewisham (Prescribed Route) (No. 3) Traffic Order 1988

Notice is hereby given that Lewisham Borough Council with consent of the Secretary of State for Transport on 15th March 1988 made the above-mentioned Order under section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and with consent of the Secretary of State for Transport with respect to any designated road, to which this Order applies, as amended by section 8 of Part I of Schedule 5 to the Local Government Act 1985.
