

C. Introduce No Waiting at Any Time and No Loading/Unloading, Monday to Friday 7.30 a.m. to 9.30 a.m. and 4 p.m. to 6.30 p.m. on:

- (a) *Limetrees Road*, both sides for its whole length, including all turning heads;
- (b) *Middleton Road*, both sides from its junction with Limetrees Road to its entry into the pedestrianised zone.

D. Introduce No Waiting at Any Time and No Loading/Unloading, Monday to Friday 8 a.m. to 9.30 a.m. and 4 p.m. to 6 p.m. on:

- (a) *Sadler Street*, westerly side from a point 75 metres from its junction with Water Street to its junction with Durnford Street.
- (b) *Durnford Street*, southerly side from a point 15 metres west of its junction with Sadler Street to a point 15 metres east of this junction.

E. Revoke Existing Orders

- (a) That part of the Borough of Middleton (*Limetrees Road/Burton Street (Part)/Park Road (Part) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1971* which relates to Limetrees Road and Burton Street shall be revoked.
- (b) That part of the Borough of Middleton (*Middleton Way (Urban Clearway) Order 1971* which relates to Limetrees Road, Factory Street and Burton Street shall be revoked.
- (c) The Borough of Middleton (*Burton Street) Traffic Regulation Order 1973* shall be revoked.
- (d) That part of the Greater Manchester County (*Various Roads, Middleton) (Prohibition of Waiting) (No. 1) (County) Order 1976* which relates to Limetrees Road, Factory Street and Burton Street shall be revoked.
- (e) The Greater Manchester County (*Burton Street and Factory Street, Middleton) (One-Way Traffic) (County) Order 1978* shall be revoked.
- (f) That part of the Greater Manchester County (*Various Roads, Rochdale/Middleton) (Clearways) (Amendments) (County) Order 1982* which relates to Limetrees Road, Factory Street and Burton Street shall be revoked.
- (g) That part of the Greater Manchester County (*Factory Street, East View and Water Street, Middleton) (Prohibition of Waiting) (County) Order 1981* which relates to Factory Street shall be revoked.
- (h) The Greater Manchester County (*Limetrees Road/Burton Street, Middleton) (Prohibition of Driving, Waiting and Loading/Unloading) shall be revoked.*
- (i) That part of the Metropolitan Borough of Rochdale (*Middleton Town Centre) (Prohibition of Driving and Traffic Regulation) (Consolidation) (Borough) Order 1987* which relates to Burton Street shall be revoked.

The proposed Order would contain certain exemptions relating to emergency vehicles and statutory undertakers, disabled persons, loading and unloading, persons boarding and alighting from vehicles.

The County of Durham (Roads A.68/A.692 Castleside Crossroads, Consett) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1988

Notice hereby gives that, the Durham County Council have made an Order under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order which comes into operation on 21st March 1988 is to prohibit the waiting by vehicles at any time on any day on the roads set out in the Schedule hereto.
