## WATER RESOURCES ACT

### NOTICE OF APPLICATION TO VARY A LICENCE TO ABSTRACT WATER

Notice is hereby given, that an application is being made to the Severn-Trent Water Authority by: G. H. Styles Limited of Horsehill Farm, Bewdley, Worcs. DY12 2TS. To vary licence serial number 18/54/8/293. To abstract water from the River Severn. At NGR SO 787736 and SO 789739.

The variation applied for is to increase abstraction rates, hourly from 55 cubic metres to 91 cubic metres, daily from 308 cubic metres to 909 cubic metres, annually from 18184 cubic metres to 27276 cubic metres. To include additional abstraction being at any point between SO 794744 and SO 793742. To include additional land as shown on deposited map supporting application to increase the period of abstraction to April to September inclusive. Also to include abstraction pump or pumps of capacity not exceeding 25.2 litres per second.

Application for licences to abstract water and to obstruct or impede the flow of an inland water. For a licence to abstract the following quantities of water from a tributary of The Gladder Brook at the following point(s) of abstraction:— 40 cubic metres per day at SO 767732, 4546 cubic metres per year on land at Park End Farm within Ribbesford Civil Parish and to obstruct or impede the flow of the watercourse at NGR SO 767732 by means of a control weir.

Further details of the application are: All water abstracted shall be used for filling storage reservoir for subsequent spray irrigation during the months of November to March inclusive.

Application for licences to abstract water for licences to abstract the following quantities of water from pools on unnamed tributaries of the River Severn at the following point(s) of abstraction:— 454 cubic metres per day at SO 771732, SO 777731, SO 778728 and SO 778723 4546 cubic metres per year at on land at Park End Farm, Horsehill Farm and Brookside Farm all within Ribbesford Civil Parish.

Further details of the application are:— All water abstracted shall be used for spray irrigation during April to September inclusive. Not more than 4546 cubic metres in total shall be abstracted from one or more of the pools.
