ACQUISITION OF LAND ACT 1981

The Secretary of State for Transport has prepared in draft the A51/A52 North of Newcastle-under-Lyme - Nantwich - Tarporley - Tarvin Trunk Road (Nantwich Bypass) (No. NW) 19 which, if confirmed, will authorise the purchase of land whichis

common as defined in the Acquisition of Land Act 1981, and the acquisition of rights over such land. The land proposed to be purchased is described in Schedule I hereto and is shown coloured pink on the map referred to in paragraph 5 below. The rights proposed to be acquired and the land over which the rights would subsist are described in the said Schedule 2 and are shown coloured blue on the map referred to in paragraph 5 below

The Acquisition of Land Act 1981 requires that the Order shall be subject to special parliamentary procedure insofar as it authorises the purchase of land forming part of a common and the acquisition of rights over such land unless the Secretary of State for

the Environment certifies that he is satisfied that:-

- (a) there has been or will be given in exchange for the common land to be purchased other land which is not less in area and is equally advantageous to the persons, if any, entitled to rights of common or other rights and to the public, and that the land given in exchange has been or will be vested in the persons in whom the land purchased was vested, and subject to the like rights, trusts and incidents as attach to the land purchased and
- (b) the common land over which rights are to subsist, when burdened with the rights will be no less advantageous to those persons in whom it is vested and to the persons, if any, entitled to rights of common or other rights, and to the public, than it was

The Secretary of State for the Environment intends to issue such a certificate to the effect that:—

- (a) there has been or will be given in exchange for the common land proposed to be purchased, described in Schedule 1 hereto, other land which fulfils the requirements of the Act of 1981 as mentioned above. The land proposed to be given in exchange is described in Schedule 3 hereto and is shown coloured green on the map referred to in paragraph 5 below:
- (b) the common land described in Schedule 2 hereto, when burdened with the rights described in the said Schedule 2, will be no less advantageous to those persons in whom it is vested and to the persons, if any, entitled to rights of common or other rights, and to the public, than it was before.

The Secretary of State wishes to know if anyone objects to the issue of such a certificate before reaching a decision and he hereby does so to give an opportunity for objections to be made. Any representations or objections in relation to the proposed certificates should be made in writing and addressed to the Secretary, Department of the Environment, Tollgate House (Room 9/22), Houlton Street, Bristol BS2 9DJ, before 20th April 1988 quoting reference DRA1/1077/485.

A map showing the common land proposed to be purchased, the common land over which the rights proposed to be acquired are to subsist, and the lands proposed to be given in exchange may be seen, without payment, at the Department of Transport, 2 Marsham Street, London S.W.1 and at the offices of the Director (Transport, 2 Marshalin Street, London S.W.1 and at the offices of the Director (Transport) North West Region, Sunley Tower, Piccadilly Plaza, Manchester MI 4BE of Cheshire County Council at County Hall, Chester and Backford Hall near Chester and of Crewe and Nantwich Borough Council, Delamere House, Delaware Street, Crewe, and also at Nantwich Public Library, Bean Street, Nantwich and Willaston Sub Post Office 73 Willaston Road, Willaston, Nantwich, at all reasonable hours.

If he considers it expedient the Secretary of State can hold a public local inquiry into the proposal to issue the certificate.
