ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The Nottinghamshire County Council (Central Core, Nottingham) (Consolidation No. 1) (Amendment No. 6) Order 1988 (Listergate)

Notice is hereby given that the Nottinghamshire County Council has made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be:

Vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding in certain parts of the following road in the city of Nottingham: Listergate.

The County of Cornwall (Bilberry) (40 m.p.h. speed limit) Order 1988
