The A46 Trunk Road (Stratford-upon-Avon Northern Bypass) (24 Hour Clearway) Order 198

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 on the Bath to Coventry to Lincoln Trunk Road (A46) known as the Stratford-upon-Avon Northern Bypass, the effect of which will be to:

- (1) prohibit waiting on the main carriageways of the bypass except upon the direction of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden;
- (2) to prohibit waiting on any verge; and
- (3) to prohibit waiting on any lay-by adjacent to those main carriageways for the purpose of selling goods, unless the goods are immediately delivered at or taken into premises adjacent to the vehicle from which the sale is effected.

Also whilst any gate or barrier at the entrance to premises to which a vehicle requires access, or from which it has emerged is opened or closed.
