HEREFORD AND WORCESTER COUNTY COUNCIL

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

The County of Hereford and Worcester (Tybridge Street, Worcester) Various Traffic Orders 1988

Notice is hereby given that on 17th March 1988 Hereford and Worcester County Council made an Order under section 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3), 4(1), and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers the effect of which will be:

(Tybridge Street, Worcester) (Box Junction) Order 1988

to provide a "yellow box" marking on the central and eastern lanes of Tybridge Street in the City of Worcester in the county of Hereford and Worcester at its junction with New Road.

No vehicle shall be driven into the boxed area and thereafter driven in such a direction that it becomes necessary, owing to the presence of stationary vehicles, for any part of the vehicle to remain at rest within the boxed area. Unless:

- (a) the direction or the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden has been obtained;
- (b) the vehicle is in use for police, fire brigade, or ambulance purposes; or
- (c) the vehicle, the driver of which when entering the boxed area had reasonable cause to believe that he would immediately be able to drive the vehicle out of that area;
- (d) the vehicle is in use in connection with work to be carried out to statutory undertakers' plant and equipment.

(Tybridge Street, Worcester) (Bus Lane) (Modification) Order 1980 (Variation) Order 1988

to reduce the length of the existing bus lane in Tybridge Street in the City of Worcester in the county of Hereford and Worcester so that it extends from the centre line of New Road for a distance of 35 metres (115 feet) in a northerly direction.

The Order will come into operation on 28th March 1988.

A copy of the Order as made and a copy of the relevant map can be inspected at County Hall, Spetchley Road, Worcester, during normal office hours.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in the Order on the ground that it is not within the powers of the relevant section of that Act or on the ground that any requirement of that section or of Parts I, II or III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 or of any regulations made under the said Part III of Schedule 9 has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within 6 weeks of the date on which the Order was made (such date stated in this notice) make application for the purpose to the High Court.
