No. 1) Order 1988*

## EAST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL

## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

*The East Sussex (Various Roads, Heathfield) (Prohibition and  
Restriction of Waiting) Order 1988*

Notice is hereby given that with reference to the public notice No. 372 which appeared in Issue No. 50911 of the *London Gazette* on 8th May 1987, East Sussex County Council has made an Order under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 which makes alterations to the waiting restrictions in several roads at Heathfield by:

(a) prohibiting waiting at any time along parts of Burwash Road (A265), Cherwell Road, Hailsham Road, Harley Lane, Holly Drive, Holly Close, Springwood Road and Streatfield Road; and

(b) limiting waiting to 2 hours in any 4 hours on Monday to Saturday along parts of Cherwell Road, Springwood Road and Streatfield Road.

These measures are intended to relieve obstruction caused by parked vehicles outside a printing works in Streatfield Road; to improve access for delivery lorries to the store area of Errey's furniture store; and to improve traffic safety generally in the area concerned. The Order will come into operation on Monday, 28th March 1988.

Exceptions are included in the Order in respect of disabled persons' vehicles and to permit picking up and setting down of passengers, loading and unloading of goods, roadworks and the maintenance of essential services.

A copy of the Order and a plan showing the lengths of roads affected may be examined at my office between the hours of 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive until 4th May 1988.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order, or of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within 6 weeks of 23rd March 1988 apply to the High Court for this purpose.
