The Ealing (Prescribed Routes) (No. 3) Traffic Order 1988

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Ealing on 25th March 1988 made the above-named Order under section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") so as to continue in force indefinitely the provisions of the Ealing (Prescribed Routes) (No. 3) Experimental Traffic Order 1986. The Order will come into operation on 30th March 1988.

The general effect of the Order will be to prohibit any goods vehicle the maximum gross weight of which exceeds 7.5 tonnes, from entering any street specified in the Schedule to this notice, hereinafter referred to as a "prescribed street".

The prohibition referred to in paragraph 2 above will not

apply:

- (a) to any person causing any vehicle to enter any prescribed street for the purpose of loading or unloading in any prescribed street or any street accessible only therefrom or for the purpose of gaining access to off-street garaging accessible only from any prescribed street;
- (b) in relation to any vehicle when used in the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties provided that in all the circumstances it is reasonably necessary in the exercise of such powers or in the performance of such duties for that vehicle to enter any prescribed street;
- (c) in relation to any vehicle being used in connection with the maintenance, improvement, reconstruction, cleansing or lighting of any prescribed street or any street accessible only therefrom, or the laying, erection, alteration or repair of any sewer thereunder or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunication system thereunder or thereon or the placing, maintenance or removal of any traffic signs thereon;
- (d) to anything done with permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform;
- (e) in respect of anything done in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed on the highway by or on behalf of the Metropolitan Police.

Thursdays inclusive and between the hours of 8.30 a.m. and 4.15 p.m. on Fridays in Room U/361, 22-24 Uxbridge Road, Ealing W5 2BP. Copies of the Order may be bought there.

Any person desiring to question the validity of the Order or any provision combined therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Act or that any of the requirements thereof or of any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with may within 6 weeks from the date on which the Order was made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
