DACORUM BOROUGH COUNCIL

*The Borough of Dacorum (Marlowes, Bridge Street and Waterhouse Street, Hemel Hempstead) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1987*

Notice is hereby given that the Dacorum Borough Council pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the County Council of Hertfordshire in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 have made an order which will have the following effects:

1. Vehicles will be prohibited from waiting at all times in the following length of road:-

*Marlowes, Hemel Hempstead*—east side from a point 35 metres south of Hillfield Road to a point 21 metres north of the north side of Bridge Street.

2. Vehicles will be prohibited from waiting for longer than 1 hour in any 2 hours between the hours of 8.30 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. Mondays to Saturdays inclusive in the following lengths of road:-

*Bridge Street, Hemel Hempstead*—north side from a point 28 yards (26 metres) west of Marlowes to a point 17 yards (15 metres) east of Waterhouse Street.

3. Vehicles will be prohibited from waiting for longer than 30 minutes in any hour between the hours of 8.30 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. Mondays to Saturdays inclusive in all following lengths of road:-

*Waterhouse Street, Hemel Hempstead*—east side from a point 22 yards (20 metres) north of Bridge Street to a point 28 yards (26 metres) northwards.

4. Parts of previous Orders affecting the above locations will be revoked.

Exemptions from the Order will permit parking for the purpose of:

- (a) picking up and setting down passengers;
  - (b) loading and unloading goods;
  - (c) emergency service vehicles;
  - (d) disabled persons' vehicles;
- and where necessary in connection with:
- (e) the maintenance of the road;
  - (f) supply of gas, water and electricity;
  - (g) works to telegraphic lines;
  - (h) delivery and collection of postal products.

Taxis while waiting at a duly authorised rank and vehicles while waiting upon a duly authorised parking place will also be exempt from the Order.

The Order will come into effect on 28th March 1988.

A copy of the Order, an explanatory statement and a map showing the lengths of roads concerned may be inspected during normal office hours at the Borough Secretary's Department at the address given below.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or any requirement of Part III of Schedule 9 to the Order has not been complied with you may do so by application to the High Court within 6 weeks of the date of publication of this notice.

DERBY CITY COUNCIL

*Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 Derby City Council (Off-street Parking Places) Order 1988*

Notice is hereby given that the Derby City Council in exercise of its powers under section 35(1) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "The Act") and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act and of all other enabling powers with the consent of the Derbyshire County Council in accordance with Section 39(3) of the Act and after consulting the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of the said Schedule 9 to the Act gives notice of its intention to make the above Order the effect of which will be as follows:—

(a) to make provision for the use of a car parking place at Sacheverel Street, Derby and in particular to specify the class of vehicles which may be entitled to use it, the conditions on which it may be used and the charges to be paid in connection with its use as a parking place as set out in Schedule One hereto.

(b) to vary the parking charges at certain car parks as stated in Schedule Two to this Notice. Only those charges indicated are to be varied and all other charges remain as at present.

(c) to revoke all former off-street parking Orders as listed in Schedule III to this Notice.

A copy of the Order, the relevant map and the Council's statement of reasons for proposing to make the Order can be inspected at the City Secretary's Department, Council House, Corporation Street, Derby (ref: T/HD/14/299 AB) Monday to Friday during normal office hours.

Any objections to the Order should be sent in writing to the City Secretary, Derby City Council at the address given above, setting out the grounds for objection by 23rd April 1988.
