

## HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

*The A36 Trunk Road  
(Codford Bypass Side Roads) Order 1988*

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he had made an Order under section 12, 14 and 125 of the Highways Act 1980, the effect of which is:

- (a) to authorise him:
- (i) to improve, raise, lower or otherwise alter highways,
  - (ii) to stop-up highways,
  - (iii) to construct new highways,
  - (iv) to stop-up private means of access to premises, and
  - (v) to provide new means of access to premises,
- all at Codford in the county of Wiltshire; and
- (b) provide for the transfer of the said new highways to the Council of Wiltshire as from the date on which he notifies the Council that the new highway has been completed and is open for through traffic.

Copies of the Order and of the relevant plans have been deposited at the Department of Transport, 2 Marsham Street, London, S.W.1 and at the offices of the Director (Transport), South West Region, Tollgate House, Houlton Street, Bristol BS2 9DJ, and of the Wiltshire County Council, County Hall, Trowbridge, Wiltshire, Warminster Public Library, New Library Building, Three Horseshoes Mall, Warminster, Wiltshire and at the Post Office, 73-74 High Street, Codford, Warminster BA12 0ND.

Copies of the Order, the title of which is "The West of Southampton to Bath Trunk Road A36 (Codford Bypass Side Roads) Order 1988", can be obtained from the Director (Transport), South West Region, Room 402, Tollgate House, Houlton Street, Bristol, BS2 9DJ.

Any person aggrieved by the Order and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980 or on the ground that any requirement of that Act, or of regulations made thereunder, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within 6 weeks from 25th March 1988, or within 6 weeks from the date of publication of this notice, if such period shall expire later, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.

## ANIMAL HEALTH ACT 1981

Notice is hereby given in pursuance of sections 1, 8(1) and 86(1) of the Animal Health Act 1981(a) that the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, the Secretary of State for Scotland and the Secretary of State for Wales, acting jointly, have made the following Order:

*The Diseases of Animals (Approved Disinfectants)  
(Amendment) Order 1988  
(SI 1988 No. 224)*

This Order amends the Diseases of Animals (Approved Disinfectants) Order 1978 by substituting new schedules for Schedules 1 and 2 to that Order (article 2(a) and (b)). Schedule 1, which lists approved disinfectants, includes newly approved disinfectants, and Schedule 2 lists disinfectants which are now omitted from Schedule 1 but which may nevertheless continue to be used as approved disinfectants until 30th June 1988 (article 2(c)).
