

STOCKPORT METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Metropolitan Borough of Stockport (Cheadle Old Road, Stockport) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 1988

Notice is hereby given that the Stockport Metropolitan Borough Council have on 25th March made an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 which shall come into operation on 1st April 1988.

The effect of the Order is to prohibit any person from causing or permitting a motor vehicle to proceed along Cheadle Old Road from the easterly kerb-line of Edgeley Fold to the southerly kerb-line of Cheadle Old Road for a distance of 3 metres in an easterly direction.

A copy of the Order and map is deposited at the Enquiry Desk, Town Hall, Stockport and may be examined between the hours of 9 a.m. and 4.30 p.m., Monday to Friday.
