

KETTERING BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Administrative Council of the Borough of Kettering (Off-street Parking Places) (Meadow Road/Commercial Road, Kettering) (Temporary Closure) Order 1988.

Notice is hereby given that the Administrative Council of the Borough of Kettering subject to obtaining the consent of the Northamptonshire County Council proposes to make the above-named temporary Order under the provisions of sections 32 and 35 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect of the proposed Temporary Order will be as follows:

- (1) To close the Meadow Road/Commercial Road, Kettering Long Stay car park temporarily.
- (2) To suspend for the duration of this Order the operation of the Borough of Kettering (Off-street Parking Places) Consolidation Order 1987 in so far as it relates to the Meadow Road/Commercial Road, Kettering Long Stay car park.

The Order will be made for a period of 12 months to enable building works to be carried out on adjacent land.

Edinburgh Road, Cornwall Road and Clarence Road, Kettering (Prohibition/Restriction of Waiting and Reversal of One-Way System) Order 1988

Notice is hereby given that the Administrative Council of the Borough of Kettering as agent of the Northamptonshire County Council proposed to make an Order under section 1(1), 2, 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit waiting in the lengths of road specified in the First Schedule to the Order, restrict waiting in the length of road specified in the Second Schedule to this Order and to reverse the direction of the one-way system in Clarence Road, Kettering.

Exceptions in the proposed Order will permit waiting for the purposes of the removal of any obstruction to traffic and where necessary, in connection with the maintenance of roads and the supply of gas, water and electricity. These exemptions will apply to disabled persons' vehicles bearing the relevant badge and to emergency service vehicles.
