

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

*The London-Portsmouth Trunk Road A3
(Liphook-Ham Barn Section Side Roads) (Part 2) Order 198*

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes, in relation to the new trunk road to be constructed by him between Liphook and Ham Barn in the county of Hampshire, to make under sections 14 and 125 of the Highways Act 1980 an Order which will:

(a) authorise him:

- (i) to improve, raise, lower or otherwise alter highways,
- (ii) to stop up highways,
- (iii) to construct new highways,
- (iv) to stop up private means of access to premises, and
- (v) to provide a new means of access to premises,

all on or in the vicinity of the route of the above mentioned new trunk road, and

- (b) provide for the transfer of the said new highways to the County Council of Hampshire as from the date on which he notifies the Council that the new highway has been completed and is open for through traffic.

Copies of the draft Order and of the relevant plans may be inspected free of charge at all reasonable hours from 18th May 1988 until 6th July 1988, or within seven weeks from the date of publication of this notice, whichever period shall expire later, at the Department of Transport, (Room P3/061), 2 Marsham Street, London S.W.1, and at the Department's South East Regional Office, Federated House, London Road, Dorking, Surrey RH4 1SZ; at the offices of Hampshire County Council,

County Surveyor's Department, (Room 412), Ashburton Court, The Castle, Winchester, Hampshire; West Sussex County Council, Roads and Transportation Section, County Secretariat, (2nd Floor, East Wing, Main Block), County Hall, Chichester, West Sussex; and East Hampshire District Council, Council Offices, Penns Place, Petersfield, Hampshire; at Petersfield Public Library, 27 The Square, Petersfield, Hampshire; and Liphook Public Library, 18 London Road, Liphook, Hampshire; and at Petersfield Post Office, 29 The Square, Petersfield, Hampshire; Liphook Post Office, Portsmouth Road, Liphook, Hampshire; Sheet Post Office, School House, School House Lane, Sheet, near Petersfield, Hampshire; Steep Post Office, 15 Church Road, Steep, near Petersfield, Hampshire; Liss Post Office, 45 Station Road, Liss, Hampshire; West Liss Post Office, Farnham Road, West Liss, Hampshire; Greatham Post Office, Petersfield Road, Greatham, near Liss, Hampshire; and Rake Post Office, Rake Stores and Wine Market, Rake, near Liss, Hampshire, where they are open to inspection free of charge at all reasonable hours.

Any person may not later than 6th July 1988 or within seven weeks from the date of publication of this notice, if such period shall expire later, object to the making of the Order, by notice to the Secretary of State at his address at the Department's South East Regional Office, Federated House, London Road, Dorking, Surrey RH4 1SZ, quoting reference RSE/A3/6B/65/2/15 and stating the grounds of objection. In the preparation of an objection and the statement of grounds of objection it should be borne in mind that the substance of any objection or representation may be communicated to other people who may be affected by it.
