ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

NORTH BEDFORDSHIRE BOROUGH COUNCIL

North Bedfordshire Borough Council (Melbourne Street, Bedford) (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 1987, Amendment No. 1

Notice is hereby given that on 26th May 1988, the North Bedfordshire Borough Council made an Order under sections 32, 35 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which is to amend the North Bedfordshire Borough Council (Melbourne Street, Bedford) (Off-street Parking Places) Order 1987 by:

- (1) increasing the parking charge for motor cars and light vans from 20p to 60p per visit;
- (2) permitting lorries to park overnight only (ie between 6 p.m. and 8 a.m.) in the car park at a charge of £1.20 per visit;
- (3) introducing a £25 excess charge (reduced to £10 if paid within 28 days) for failing to display a valid parking ticket.

A copy of the Order, which will come into effect on 1st June 1988, may be examined at the address below during normal office hours.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order, or any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act or of any Instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within 6 weeks from 26th May 1988, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

NORTH BEDFORDSHIRE BOROUGH COUNCIL

Borough of Bedford (Off-street Parking Places) Order 1969, Amendment No. 1/1988

BOURNEMOUTH BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Borough of Bournemouth (Hood Crescent Northern Arm) (One-way Traffic) Order 1988
