Milton Keynes Development Corporation Extinguishment of Public Rights of Way Over Part of Walton Road at Walnut Tree and Wavendon Gate, Milton Keynes

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of his powers under section 23 of the New Towns Act 1981, proposes to make an Order extinguishing the public rights of way over the following routes shown by a thick black line on the map hereinafter referred to:

That part of Walton Road at Walnut Tree which runs from a point marked on the map (located approximately 280 metres east of No. 2 Coronation Cottages, Walton) in a generally south easterly direction for approximately 290 metres to a point marked B on the map located adjacent to the access road to the abundance nursery.
