*The Canterbury City Council (Off-street Parking Places)
(Amendment No. 1) Order 1988*

Notice is hereby given that the Canterbury City Council proposes to make the above Order under sections 32 and 35 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, with the consent of the Kent County Council under section 39(3) of the said Act of 1984.

CHESHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
