

The Causeway/London Road, south-west side, from a point 62 metres south-east of Burlands Road for a distance of 22 metres in a south-easterly direction.

Ivy Lane, both sides, from its junction with Bath Road to its junction with New Road.

Marshfield Road

Both sides, from its junction with New Road in a westerly direction to a point 55 metres west of its junction with Dailas Road.

Both sides, the whole of the link road leading north from its junction with Ivy Lane.

New Road (north-east of the Western Arches) both sides, from a point 55 metres south-west of its junction with Union Road to the Railway Viaduct at the Western Arches.
