UNIVERSITIES OF OXFORD AND CAMBRIDGE ACT 1923

Statute made by the Governing Body of Magdalen College, in the University of Oxford on 4th December 1985 and 2nd December 1987, amending Statutes IV, VIII, XI and XIII has been submitted for the approval of Her Majesty in Council, and notice of its having been so submitted is published in accordance with provisions of the Universities of Oxford and Cambridge Act 1923.

The amendments establish a new Visiting Fellowship; clarify the rights of persons subject to the College's Superannuation Scheme; and establish a company limited by guarantee and registered as a charity to run Magdalen College School, Oxford. (1 SI)

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971
