The Proposed Barnsley Metropolitan Borough Council (Smithies) Smoke Control Order No. 55 1988

Notice is hereby given that the Barnsley Metropolitan Borough Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act 1956 (as amended by the Local Government, Planning and Land Act 1980) intend to make an Order entitled The Barnsley Metropolitan Borough Council (Smithies) Smoke Control Order No. 55, 1988 declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a smoke control area. Subject to the exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of sub-section (4) of section 11 of the Clean Air Act 1956, if on any day after the Order has come into operation smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area, the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £400 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

If made the Order will not come into operation before the 1st September 1989 or before a later date determined by the Council. Copies of the proposed Order and the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the offices of Consumer and Environmental Services, Regent House, Regent Street, Barnsley at all reasonable times during the period of 6 weeks from 15th July 1988.

Within the said period any person who will be affected by the proposed Order may by notice to the Director of Consumer and Environmental Services, Regent House, Regent Street, Barnsley, object to the making of the Order.

Notice is hereby given that the Barnsley Metropolitan Borough Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act 1956 (as amended by the Local Government, Planning and Land Act 1980) intend to make an Order entitled the Barnsley Metropolitan Borough Council (Darfield) Smoke Control Order No. 57, 1988 declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a smoke control area. Subject to the exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of sub-section (4) of section 11 of the Clean Air Act 1956, if on any day after the Order has come into operation smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area, the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £400 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

If made the Order will not come into operation before the 1st September 1990, or before a later date determined by the Council. Copies of the proposed Order and the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the offices of Consumer and Environmental Services, Regent House, Regent Street, Barnsley, at all reasonable times during the period of 6 weeks from 15th July 1988.

Within the said period any person who will be affected by the proposed Order may by notice to the Director of Consumer and Environmental Services, Regent House, Regent Street, Barnsley, object to the making of the Order.
