TOWN AND COUNTRY GENERAL REGULATIONS 1976

Any claim must be served on the Council at its above address within a period of 6 months from 22nd July 1988, unless the period is extended in any particular case by the Secretary of State.

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971
