- (1) an Order under section 10 of the Highways Act 1980 which will provide that roads which he proposes to construct along two routes for slip roads to connect the south-bound carriageway of the A12 Trunk Road with a proposed new highway at Capel St. Mary and Bentley in the County of Suffolk, shall become trunk roads as from the date when the Order comes into force;
- (2) an Order under sections 14 and 125 of the Highways Act 1980 authorising him:
  - (a) to improve, raise, lower or otherwise alter highways,
  - (b) to stop-up highways,
  - (c) to construct new highways,
  - (d) to stop-up private means of access to premises, and
- (e) to provide new means of access to premises, all at Capel St. Mary and Bentley aforesaid, and providing for the transfer of each of the said new highways to the County Council of Suffolk as from the date on which he notifies the Council that the new highways have been completed and are open for through traffic; and
- (3) an Order under sections 1(1) and (2) and 2(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which will be to prohibit any vehicle proceeding in either carriageway of the A12 Trunk Road from entering or proceeding through the gaps in the central reservation opposite the junctions of that road with Pond Hall Lane (C456, The Street (C470), Bentley Road (C426) and London Road (South) (C472). Vehicles being used for police, fire brigade and ambulance purposes will be exempt from the prohibition as it applies to the gap opposite the junction with London Road (South).

Copies of the draft Orders together with the relevant plans, a statement explaining the Secretary of State's reasons for proposing to make the Orders and an environmental impact assessment may be inspected free of charge at all reasonable hours from 14th July 1988 until 2nd September 1988, or within seven weeks from the date of publication of this notice, whichever period shall expire later, at the Department of Transport, Room P3/061, 2 Marsham Street, London S.W.1., and at the offices of the Director (Transport) Eastern Region, Heron House, 49–53 Goldington Road, Bedford; and of Suffolk County Council, County Hall, Ipswich; and Babergh District Council, Corks Lane, Hadleigh; the Library, Capel St. Mary, and the Post Offices at Capel St. Mary and Bentley.

Any person may not later than 2nd September 1988, or within seven weeks from the date of publication of this notice, if such period shall expire later, object to the making of the Orders, by notice to the Secretary of State at his address at the office of the Director (Transport) Eastern Region, quoting ref. 50 7565/2/A12/95, and stating the grounds of objection. In the preparation of an objection
