COAST PROTECTION ACT

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE COAST PROTECTION ACT 1949

Works at Ness Point, Lowestoft, Suffolk

Notice is hereby given that Waveney District Council, acting as Coast Protection Authority for the frontage of coastline incorporating Ness Point, hereby give notice of its intention to carry out Coast Protection works to reconstruct a section of sea wall known as 'Silver Rail', north of Ness Point, Lowestoft, Suffolk.

The original structure, being the only remaining part of a wall built in 1923, is located at the most exposed point of the North Lowestoft defence system which protects the low lying Denes area, including valuable industrial development from flooding by the sea.

Throughout its history the Silver Rail Sea Wall has been the subject of several major reconstruction schemes reflecting the continuing trend of scour at this exposed site.

The existing toe piling has recently become undermined over part of the frontage posing a threat to the overall stability of the structure and highlighting the need for prompt action.

It is intended to phase the repair over 2 years. The initial scheme will consist of replacing the steel toe piling and providing an anti-scour mattress to prevent further lowering of the sea bed immediately in front of the defences. The second phase will consist of the provision of a suitable groyne system and revetment to further stabilise the immediate foreshore area.

Phase I is programmed to commence in October 1988 with Phase II to be completed by not later than April 1990.

The whole scheme estimate is £790,000.
