

Exceptions will be provided in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait with police permission or for passengers to board or alight, for the loading and unloading of goods, for enabling work to be carried out in or adjacent to the road, for disabled persons and for emergency service vehicles.

Classes of vehicles: Motor cars and motor cycles as defined by the proposed Order (with the addition of heavy goods vehicles and public service vehicles as defined by the proposed Order in the heavy goods vehicle parking places only).

Days and hours of operation of Parking places: All days and all hours.

Charging hours: All hours except that a vehicle may be parked over-night free of charge provided that it has entered the parking place after 8 p.m. and left the parking place before 8 a.m. during the same 12-hour period (not applicable to free car parks).

Motor cycles: All motor cycles may park free of charge.

For a period exceeding 8 hours but not exceeding 24 hours, £1.50.
For each additional period of 24 hours or part thereof in those parking places marked* in section 2(1) above, £1.50.
