The Oldham Town Centre Experimental Traffic Regulation Order 1987 (Amendment) Order 1988

The Oldham (Hathershaw Lane, Oldham) Prohibition of Waiting Order 1988

Notice is hereby given that the Oldham Borough Council propose to make an Order under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to prohibit waiting at any time in the length of road specified in the Schedule to this notice.

Exemptions:

- (a) to enable persons to board or alight from a vehicle;
- (b) to enable goods to be loaded onto or unloaded from a vehicle;
- (c) vehicles used for building or demolition operations, funerals, weddings, roadworks, works on sewers or statutory undertakers equipment;
- (d) vehicles used in pursuance of statutory powers and duties;
- (e) disabled persons' vehicles for up to 2 hours, return prohibited within one hour.
