NEW TOWNS ACT 1981

Telford Development Corporation: Order for the Extinguishment of Public Rights of Way

Whereas (1) by virtue of section 23(1) of the New Towns act 1981, the Secretary of State for the Environment (hereinafter called "the Secretary of State") may by order extinguish any public rights of way over land which has been acquired and is for the time being held by a development corporation for the purposes of the New Towns Act 1981.

(2) the Telford Development Corporation has applied to the Secretary of State for an order extinguishing the public rights of way over the routes described in the Schedule hereto, being rights of way to which the said Act applies;

(3) the Secretary of State has caused a notice to be published in accordance with the provisions of section 23(2) of that Act;

Now therefore the Secretary of State, in exercise of the power given to him in that behalf, hereby orders as follows:-

(1) In this Order, "map" means one of the 4 maps prepared in duplicate, signed by an Assistant Secretary in the Department, marked "Maps referred to in the Telford Development Corporation (Western District Road and West Town Centre Link Road) Rights of Way Order 1988", and duly numbered for reference, one duplicate of which is deposited and availabe at the offices of the Telford Development Corporation, Priorslee Hall, Telford TF2 9NT, and the other at the offices of the Secretary of State.

(2) The public rights of way over each of the routes which is described in the Schedule hereto and which is shown coloured red in the map therein mentioned shall be extinguished as from the date of this Order.

(3) This Order may be cited as the Telford Development Corporation (Western District Road and West Town Centre Link Road) Rights of Way Order 1988.

SCHEDULE

1. That part of Station Road, Lawley starting from a point marked A on map 1, situated approximately 240 metres west of the junction of Station Road with the disused railway crossing, and running in a generally south-easterly direction for a distance of approximately 320 metres to a point marked B.

2. That part of Station Road starting from a point marked C on

That part of Station Road starting from a point marked C on map 2 situated approximately 140 metres south-west of the junction of Station Road and Arleston Lane, and running in a north-easterly and then south-easterly direction for a total distance of approximately 225 metres to a point marked D.

3. That part of Arleston Lane starting from a point marked E on map 2, situated at the junction with Station Road, and running in a northerly direction for a distance of approximately 70 metres to a point marked F.

4. That part of Rock Road starting from a line marked G-G1 on map 3, at the junction with Milners Lane, and running in a northerly direction for a distance of approximately 330 metres to a point

marked H.

5. That part of Dawley Road starting from a point marked I on map 4, situated approximately 100 metres south east of the boundary of number 8, The Crescent, Lawley, and running in a south-easterly direction for a distance of approximately 220 metres to a point marked J.

6. That part of the A4169 Wellington Road starting from a point marked K on map 4, situated approximately 590 metres south of the boundary to "Ralph's Garage", and running in a southerly direction for a distance of approximately 110 metres to a point marked L.
