Notice is hereby given that North Tyneside Metropolitan Borough Council proposes to make the above mentioned Orders under Section 1(1) and 1(2), 2(1), 2(3), 32, 35, 45, 46, 49 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The general effect of the Orders and Variation Orders if made will be:—

1. To alter the "on street" parking charge for Norfolk Street from 20p for 4 hours to 10p for 2 hours and the charge in the Norfolk Street off Street Car Park to 20p for 4 hours and 30p for a period exceeding four hours.

2. To allow public service vehicles to park on the Trinity Road Car Park, Whitley Bay at a daily charge of £1.00.
3. To introduce a facility for the parking of Police vehicles only, in Upper Pearson Street, North Shields, north side, adjacent to the Police Station.
4. To amend the existing scheme for residents parking in Military Road and Drummond Terrace, North Shields by the removal of the facility on that length of the highway opposite the southern boundary of 2-4 Military Road and the provision of the same on the west side of Drummond Terrace near the end of back Drummond Terrace/Military Road.
5. To relax existing waiting restrictions in places and prohibit waiting in other locations, within the town centre fringe area, with time limits during certain times and with an exemption from the time limits for resident permit holders at certain locations, all as specified in the Schedule to this Notice.
6. Exceptions will permit waiting for the purposes of (a) the picking up and setting down of passengers; (b) goods to be loaded onto or unloaded from the vehicle; and a number of necessary purposes.

A copy of the proposed Orders and a copy of the Authority's statement of reasons for proposing to make the aforementioned Orders are available for inspection at the Secretary and Chief Legal Adviser's Office, 14 Northumberland Square, North Shields on Mondays to Thursdays (8.30 a.m. to 5 p.m.) and Fridays (8.30 a.m. to 4.30 p.m.) until the expiration of the period of 21 days from the date on which this Notice is published.

Any person desiring to object to the proposed orders or any part thereof should send a statement in writing of his objection and the grounds thereof to the Secretary and Chief Legal Adviser at the undermentioned address within the aforementioned period of 21 days.
