GATESHEAD METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Borough Council of Gateshead (Lockhaugh Road, Rowlands Gill) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 1988

Notice is hereby given that on 18th July 1988, the Borough Council of Gateshead made an Order under section 1(1) and (2), 2(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

MID GLAMORGAN COUNTY COUNCIL

Mid Glamorgan County Council (Various Streets, The Quar, Merthyr Tydfil) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1988

Notice is hereby given that the Mid Glamorgan County Council propose to make an Order under sections 1, 2 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 the effect of which will be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles at any time on the lengths of roads and sides of lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this notice.

Lengths of roads and sides of lengths of roads in the Borough of Merthyr Tydfil

(i) *Mount Street*, the north-western side, from its junction with the south-western side of Grawen Terrace south-westwards for a distance of 15 metres (16 yards).

(ii) *Mount Street*, the south-eastern side, from its junction with the south-western side of Grawen Terrace south-westwards to its junction with the north-eastern side of Morgan Street, a distance of approximately 24 metres (26 yards).

(iii) *Grawen Terrace*, on the south-western side, from its junction with the south-eastern side of Mount Street south-eastwards for a distance of 15 metres (16 yards).

(iv) *Grawen Terrace*, on the south-western side, from its junction with the north-western side of Mount Street north-westwards for a distance of 15 metres (16 yards).

(v) *Morgan Street*, on both sides, from its junction with the south-eastern side of Mount Street south-eastwards for a distance of 15 metres (16 yards).

(vi) *Well Street*, on the western side, from its junction with the north-eastern side of Morgan Street northwards for a distance of 22 metres (24 yards).

(vii) *Well Street*, on the eastern side, from its junction with the northern side of Stuart Street northwards for a distance of 25 metres (28 yards).

(viii) *Stuart Street*, on both sides, from its junction with Dane Street north-westwards for a distance of 15 metres (16 yards).

(ix) *Unnamed Road flanking number 19 Stuart Street*, on both sides, from its junction with Stuart Street south-westwards for a distance of 15 metres (16 yards).

(x) *Grawen Terrace*, on the north-eastern side, from its junction with the western side of Well Street north-westwards for a distance of 15 metres (16 yards).
