**WIRELESS TELEGRAPHY ACT 1967***Authority given under section 7*

WHEREAS:

A. The import of certain wireless telegraphy apparatus is restricted by the Wireless Telegraphy (Citizens' Band and Amateur Apparatus) (Various Provisions) Order 1988 (S.I.1988/1215) (the "Order"); and

B. the Secretary of State is satisfied that this Authority and the terms and conditions attached to it are compatible with the international obligations of the United Kingdom:

Therefore the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 7 of the Wireless Telegraphy Act 1967 (c.72), gives his authority to any person to import the Apparatus described in paragraph 1 into the United Kingdom and to keep it in his custody and control, subject to the terms and conditions specified in paragraphs 2 and 3.

1. This Authority applies to CB apparatus which operates on any of the frequencies specified in paragraph 1.3 of Part A of MPT 1333, which has been approved by a country listed in the Annex to Schedule 2 to the Order and marked in accordance with that schedule and which complies in all respects with the Order save that
